Blot Brother Tobacco Co. put its buyers in the county sheds for the first time. Prior to that time, the top through price reported was 25 cents.

Some farmers report buyers are finding resistance to the 30 and 20 bids, but others report they believe that quite a few crops have been sold at that figure.

Absent from the market up to Thursday afternoon, and then only lightly, was Bayuk Cigars, Inc., one of the traditionally big buyers of the county leaf.

Farmers are speculating on how much of the current crop Bayuk will need to maintain its inventories, since third quarter earning reports showed Bayuk sales

were down.

Reports from farmers indicate the buyers are interested in the top crops and seem willing to go the limit on the smaller leaf since it appears to be in a little better shape than the larger tobacco. Lower tiers in many county sheds show some damage, but the good leaf is excellent with high burn qualities.

Farmers contacted late in the week were reluctant to estimate how much of the crop had been bought, but many thought the percentage was small.

**QUALITY BED LINENS**

Sheets and pillowcases should be free from defects as flaws reduce wearing qualities, states Erma Langford, Penn State extension home furnishings specialist. Quality linens should have an equal number of threads woven crosswise and lengthwise. Smooth, evenly stitched hems add to attractiveness and durability, and tape selvages add strength to the sides of sheets. Be sure to read the label for sheet and pillowcase sizes. Also know the sizes you need.
