(From page 1). land," Wiggins said. Wiggins put the conservation plan into effect immediately, plowing up some of his hay crop to get the strips established in one season.

Wiggins owns 15 acres, he rents another 20 acres and farms another 15 acres on the shares. On his rented land as well as his home farm, he farms on contour strips.

In addition to the contour strips, Wiggins added a permanent sod waterway about two years after the original plan was put into effect. He says a small cropland terrace has been suggested, but he feels the measures he now uses gives excellent control. He is not sure the terrace will not be added later.

Wiggins follows the standard county rotation of sod, corn and tobacco, and small grains. He normally grows about 10 acres of tobacco each year.

The livestock program on the farm includes 15 head of feeder steers and about a like number of fattening hogs.

The conservation farmer is 48 years old, is married and has three children. Both the boys are away from home. His daughter is a senior at Penn Manor High School.
