**JIFFY HOT BEEF SANDWICH SUPPER**

12-oz can chopped beef steaks with gravy  
3 to 4 oz package dehydrated mashed potatoes  
4 slices white or whole wheat bread  
Catsup  
Canned or frozen French-fried onion rings

Heat beef steaks with gravy  
Prepare mashed potatoes as directed on package  
Toast bread and spread with catsup. Top with beef steaks  
Spoon the gravy over meat.  
Serve with hot seasoned mashed potatoes and crisp hot onion rings  
Garnish with pickles and radishes.

**NOTE** White or whole wheat sandwich buns may be used instead of bread

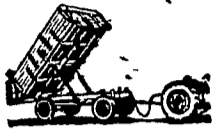
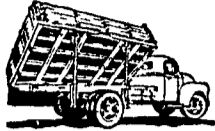

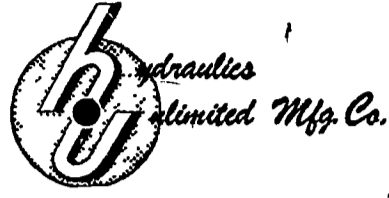
