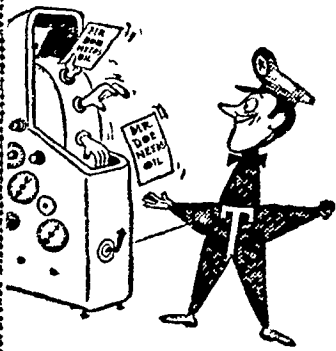

Harrisburg, Pa. — The Pennsylvania State Farm Products Show Commission today announced that the 1961 Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition will be held November 6 through 11 at the Farm Show Buildings here.

Commission Chairman William L. Henning, State Secretary of Agriculture, said that the dates will allow exhibitors of swine, beef cattle and sheep to move their animals from the Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition to Timonium, Md., for the Eastern National Livestock Show which follows the next week.

This is the fifth outing for the Pennsylvania Livestock Exposition which currently ranks at or near the top in the East for the quality of its swine, sheep and carcass shows. It is sponsored by the State Farm Products Show Commission, an administrative commission of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.
