Dinner In A Casserole

Chicken is always a favorite ingredient for a casserole. Doesn't this "Country Gravy Chicken" sound as good as it obviously tastes? Most casseroles can be prepared earliy in the day; the baking process can be finished at mealtime.

COUNTRY GRAVY CHICKEN

- 1 cup flour
- 5 teaspoons salt
- ½ teaspoon pepper 3 large chicken breasts, halved
- ¼ cup (½ stick) butter
- 1 tablespoon flour
- 1 cup milk
- ½ clove garlic, diced, or ¼ teaspoon garlic powder ½ teaspoon salt
- 2 table poons chopped par sley -
- 1/2 teaspoon rosemary 14 cup chopped green onions
- ½ cup diced celery ½ cup (4 ounce can) sliced mushrooms
- Mix flour, salt and pepper in a paper bag Shake chicken pieces, one at a time, in bag to coat thoroughly. Brown chicken in melted butter in large skillet. Arrange chicken pieces in a shallow 2-quart casserole. Blend 1 tablespoon flour with the fat remaining in the skillet to form a smooth paste. Remove from heat. Add milk, garlic and salt, stir until blended Return to heat and cook, stirring constantly, until -mixture reaches simme.ing point. Set aside Sprinkle the parsley, rosemary, onions, celery and mushrooms evenly aver the chicken in the casserole. Top with prepared gravy and bake 45 minutes in a 350 de-
