**ROSES NEED PRUNING** When new shoots appear on roses, it is time to prune these plants. Remove old or dead wood to keep the plant young and vigorous, advises Lynn Smith, extension flower specialist at Penn State. Do not prune climbers and rambler roses until after they have bloomed or you will remove flower-buds.
