The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending March 31 was down one point from the previous week at 3 6 Broilers averaged 16-85 cents per pound and mash cost \$94 90 per ton The ratio for the corresponding week a year earlier was 3 9 when broilers brought 18 11 and mash cost \$92.72 per ton.
