"Every year it is necessary to send ed nearly 500 24-quart crat out equipment and men to clean out road ditches which have-silted with soil from farm fields. Soil conservation practices such as contour strips and diversion terraces would reduce the frequency with which these ditches must be cleaned.'

A Highways Department study in York County has shown that road maintenance costs are 16 fimes as high in areas where farmers do not use conservation practices as in areas where farmers plow carefully and use soil conserving practices.

Hourly earnings of food marketing workers is up 70 percent, but the labor cost of a pound of food has risen only 34 percent. Increased efficiency has held down costs.
