Poultry Condemnations Management Is Key To Quality

WASHINGTON — Dr. Morris S. Cover, chairman of the department of animal & poultry science, University of Delaware, reported the results of a survey on poultry condemnations at a research conference on poultry health at Jefferson Auditorium, Washington, D. C. recently.

Cover said the cooperative survey by the Universities of Maryland and Delaware, showed the following management factors to influence the rate of broiler condemnations on the Delmarva Peninsula.

The use of only one stove for a large number of chicks tended to increase the rate of condemnation.

Condemnations were less among broilers raised in narrow houses (4.39 percent) than in wide houses (6.98 percent).

Houses with solid partitions between pens had condemnations averaging 3.32 percent while houses with

open partitions averaged 7.87 percent condemnations.

A definite sanitation plan such as litter removal and broiler house disinfection between flocks showed a reduction in condemnation rate. Of the washed and disinfected houses, 86 percent had less than 4 percent condemnation. Of the houses that were not washed and disinfected, only 63 percent had less than 4 percent condemnation.

The average condemnation rate on flocks receiving the recommended vaccination program was 2.39 percent while flocks receiving other vaccination programs varied from 3.56 percent to as high as 9.23 percent condemnation.

Dr. Cover told research scientists that the survey does not produce conclusive evidence, but it does show

trends which indicate that good management and disease control practices reduce condemnation rates.

Another survey, now nearly completed, shows the same trends, and the results have encouraged more vigorous sanitation and management programs in the Delmarva broiler industry.

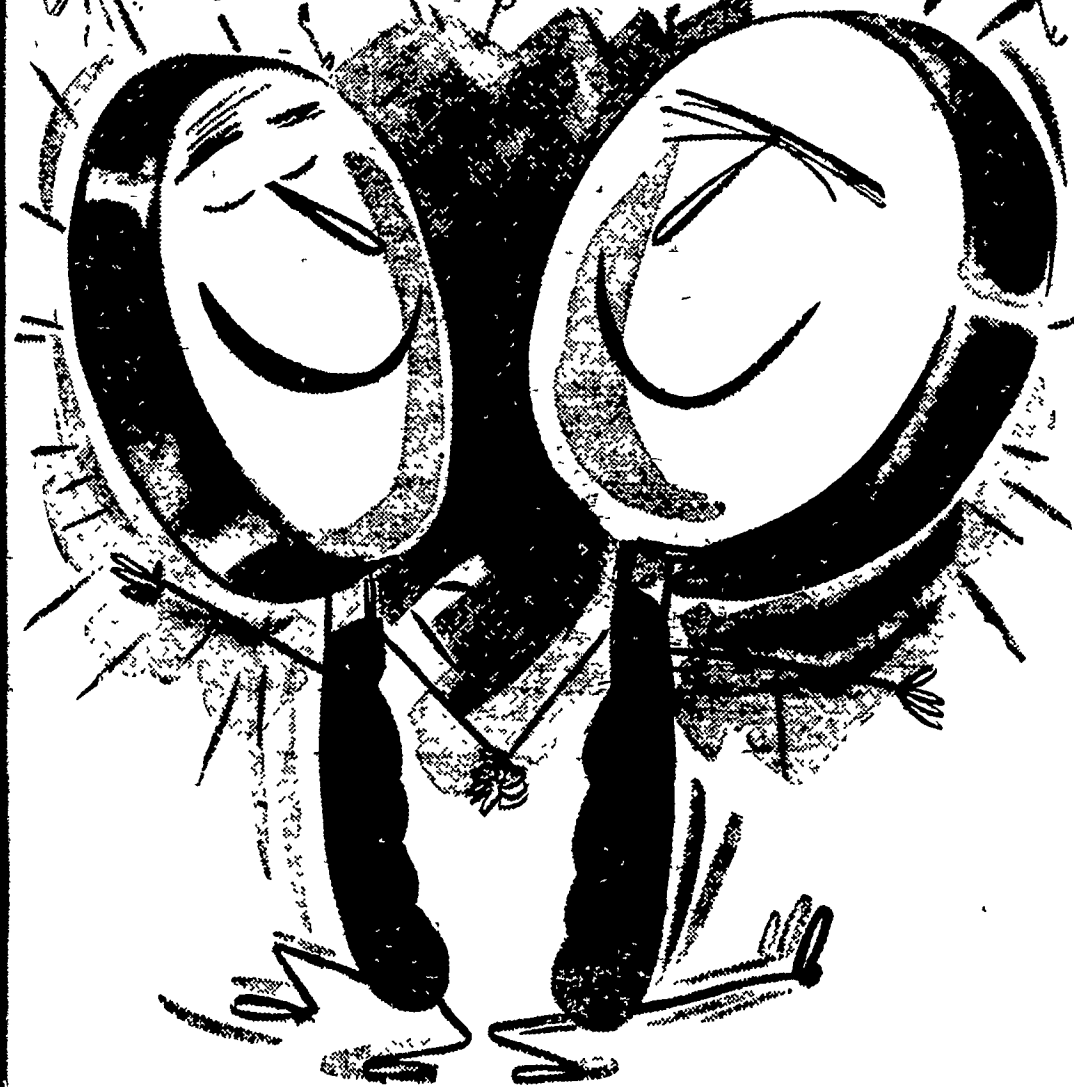
RIBOFLAVIN SOURCE
