low heat, stirring—constantly until marshmallows are melted and mixture is well blended. Remove from heat. Add cereal and stir until well-coated with marshmallow mixture. Press warm mixture lightly into buttered 13x9-inch pan. Cut into squares when cool.

NOTE: 2 cups marshmallow creme may be substituted for marshmallows. Cook with butter over low heat about 5 minutes, stirring constantly.

CHOCOLATE DROPS

1 6-oz. package (1 cup) semi-sweet chocolate pieces.
 1/2 cup chopped pecans or walnuts
 1 1/2 cups presweetened puffed rice cereal
 1/2 teaspoon salt
 Melt chocolate pieces in double boiler. Add nuts, cereal, and salt; mix lightly, using rubber scraper. Drop by teaspoonfuls onto waxed paper. Let harden in cool place but do not put in refrigerator.

CRANBERRY SAUSAGE CORN CAKE

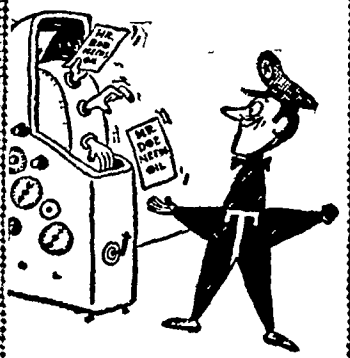
1 package corn muffin mix
 12 pork sausage links
 1 pound can whole cranberry sauce
 Bake corn muffin mix in 8x8x2" pan until golden brown according to directions on package. Fry sausages over low heat until it is brown and done. Heat cranberry sauce. Cut corn bread into rectangles 2x4" and arrange on serving plates. Place 2 or 3 link sausages over serving. Ladle hot cranberry sauce over top and serve immediately. Makes 6 servings.

Use left-over ham in this recipe—

CRANBERRY HAM LOAF

1 cup jellied cranberry sauce
 1/2 teaspoon allspice
 Dash cloves
 3 cups ground cooked ham
 1 cup dry bread crumbs
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 2 tablespoons minced onion
 1/4 cup minced green pepper
 2 tablespoons prepared mustard
 2 eggs, slightly beaten
 3/4 cup milk

Crush cranberry sauce with a fork. Combine cranberry sauce, allspice, and cloves. Pour into bottom of greased mold. Combine ham, bread crumbs, salt, onion, and green pepper. Mix mustard with eggs and add to ham mixture. Stir in the milk. Pack in mold on top of spiced cranberry sauce. Bake in 375 degree oven for 45 minutes. Makes 6 to 8 servings.

CRANBERRY STAR TAFFIES

2 tablespoons butter or margarine
 6 tablespoons brown sugar
 4 rings pineapple
 4 cranberry sauce star cutouts

Crumble brown sugar and butter together. Arrange the cranberry star cutout on top of each slice of pineapple. Carefully sprinkle sugar-butter mixture over top. Place in shallow pan. Bake in moderate oven 350 degrees for 30 minutes or place on broiler pan and broil with tops of cranberry pineapple taffies about 3 inches from broiler flame. Taffies will take about 10 minutes to broil.

In the frying pan—melt the butter and add the brown sugar. Stir well and add the pineapple rings. When pineapple rings are hot and a golden brown, place star cutouts in the syrupy mixture

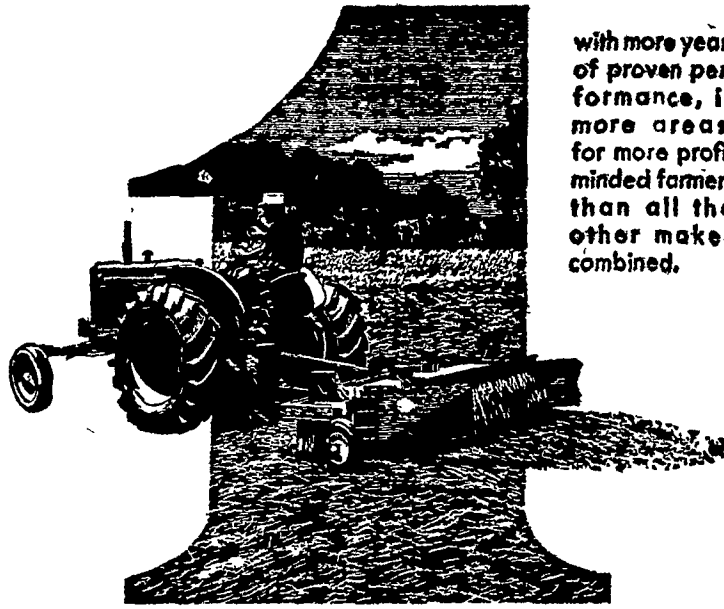

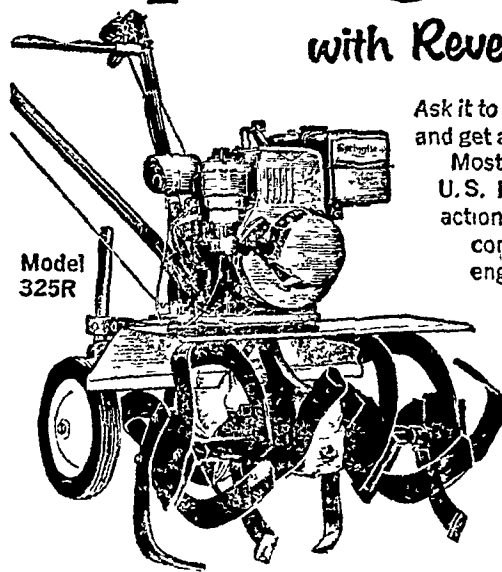

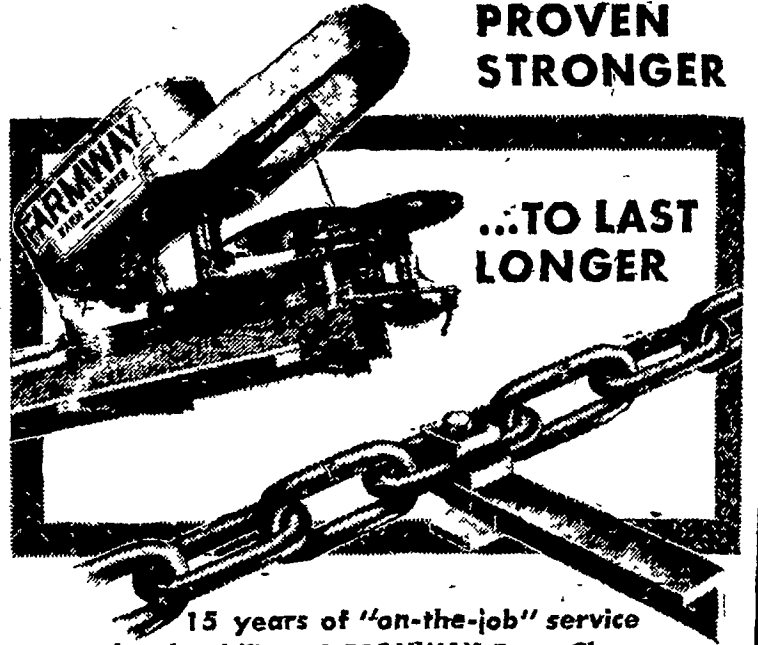
