

## Electric Co. Plans Meeting Of Shareholders

Annual meeting "In the round" will be an innovation in the 41st shareholders meeting of the Pennsylvania Power and Light Co.

The meeting, scheduled for Monday, April 17, will be held under 15,000 square feet of candy-striped canvas at the Brunner Island site of the company's new power plant.

Shareholders will be transported to the meeting on a special train running from Philadelphia through Harrisburg to the plant along the Susquehanna River south of Harrisburg.

The tent will be heated electrically by power from the new facilities.

It is necessary to have large acreages of grazing land will wonder how the Purebred Guernseys at Maple Springs can produce their records with only six acres of pasture.

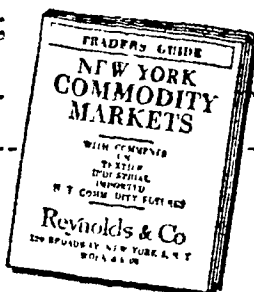
