

Breeding Co-ops Approve Grant For Dairy Cattle Research Work

University Park, Pa.—The Pennsylvania State Association of Artificial Breeding Cooperatives, long a liberal supporter of dairy research, today launched on a new program of expanded aid to the state's dairy industry.

At its 1961 meeting, just held at Penn State University, the association voted a new grant of \$13,126 for dairy breeding research at the University, and initiated a "Robert H. Olmstead Memorial Fellowship Fund" for use in any phase of dairy scientific inquiry.

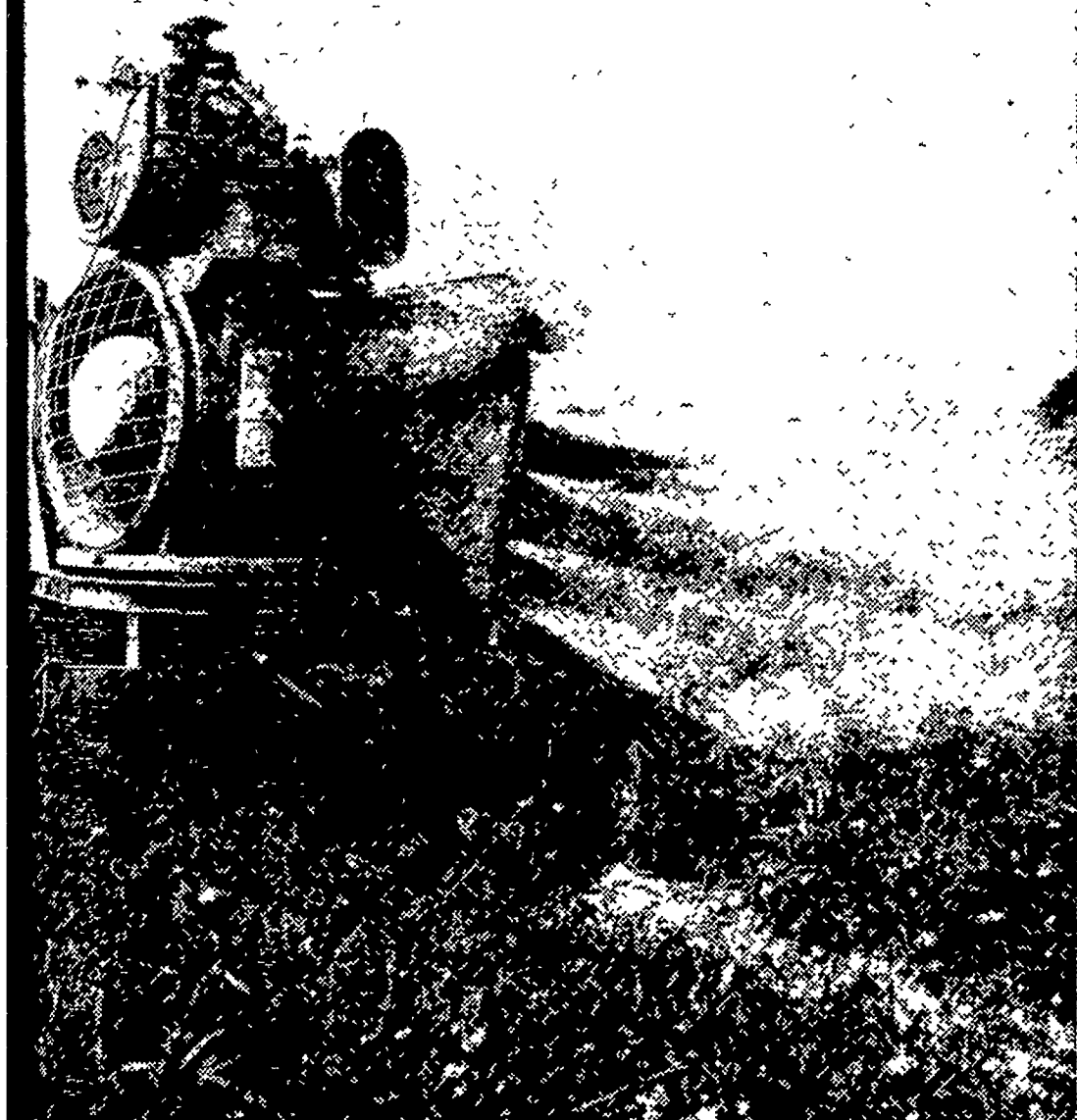
The association also reelected officers and reported new high achievements in breeding efficiency and in total volume of work. George L. Carlson, Turtle Point, McKean county, was renamed president. Retained with him were Wilmer M. Hill, Slatington, Lehigh county, vice president; J. Lewis Williams, Uniontown, Fayette county, secretary-treasurer, and two directors, Earl L. Groff, Strasburg, Lancaster county, and George B. Butler, Wellsboro, Tioga county.

The new grant of the University brought to \$171,512.80 the total given by the State ABC for dairy breeding studies. A committee of Carlson, the other officers and managers of five member service cooperatives was (Turn to page 9)

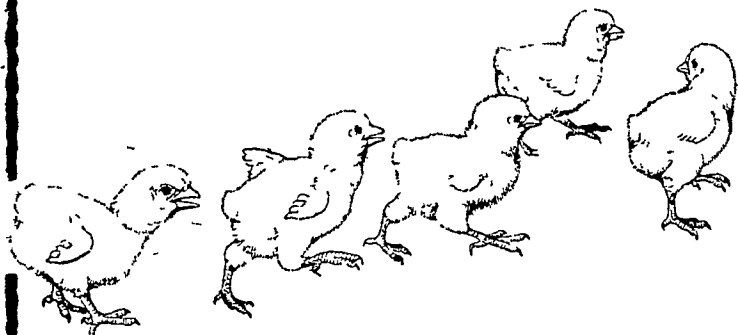
