Add sour cream, raisins and lemon juice over hot water until thick

stirring constantly. Cool Add walnuts and pour into baked pastry shell. Top with meringue. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees) about 15 to 18 minutes until delicately

browned. To make meringue, beat egg whites until frothy. Add cream of tartar and continue beating until peaks begin to form. Gradually beat in remaining ¼ cup sugar, beating until stiff and glossy. Makes one 9-inch pie.

8 minutes. Cool.

Filling:
1 pound 14-ounce can apricot halves
1½ teaspoons unflavored gelatine
¼ cup apricot syrup
3-ounce package cream cheese, softened
¼ cup sugar
6-ounce can evaporated milk, well-chilled
2 tablespoons lemon juice

1 teaspoon grated lemon rind
Drain apricot halves, reserving syrup. Save 7 apricot halves for garnish, remaining halves into small pieces. Soften gelatine in cup apricot syrup, dissolved over hot water. Blend softened cream cheese and sugar. Add dissolved gelatine. Whisk chilled milk until fluffy.
