

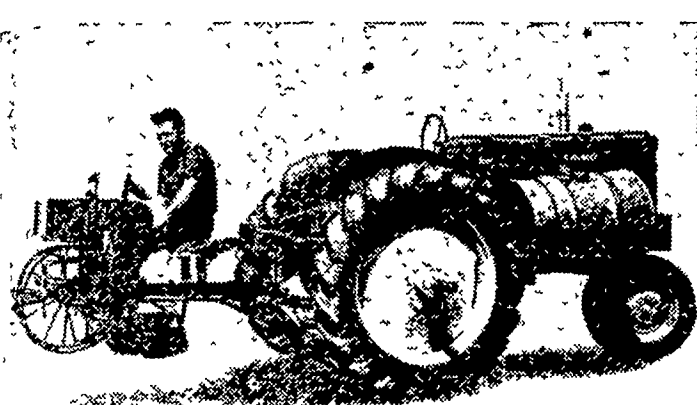
Feed Firm Adds Representative

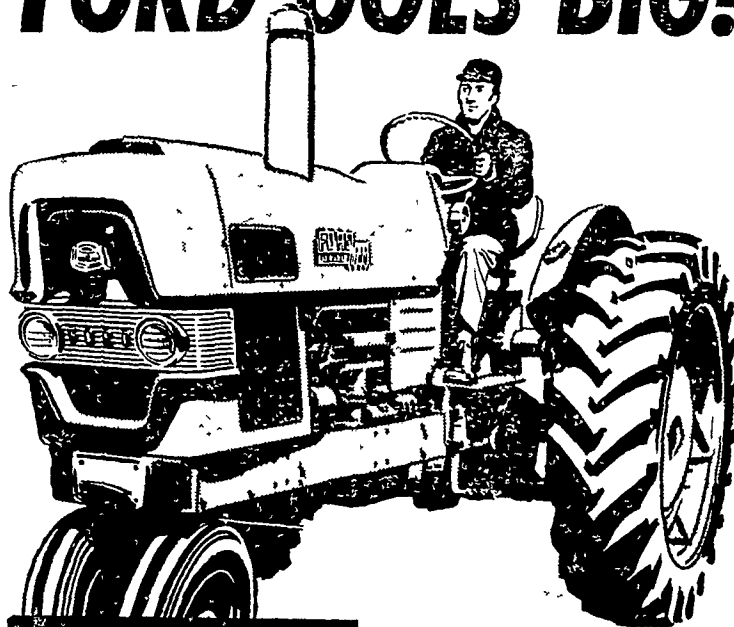

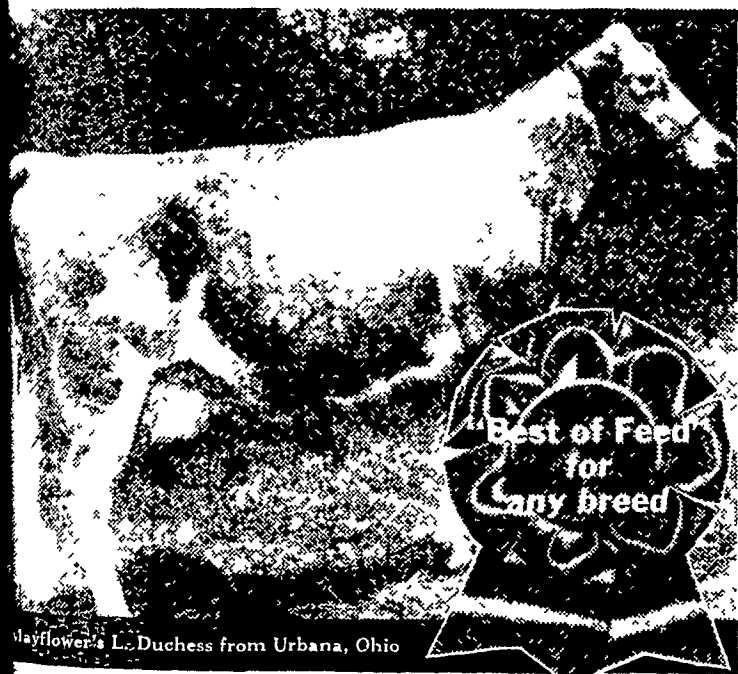
