add broth gradually, stirring constantly. Add remaining ingredients and cook until raisins are plump and mixture is thickened, stirring occasionally. Serve hot with ham or tongue. Makes about 1 1/2 cups

- 1 cup shortening
- 2 cups brown sugar
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 3 cups cake flour
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 teaspoons soda
- 1/2 teaspoon cloves
- 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
- 1 cup sour milk
- 1 cup chopped nuts
- 1 cup chopped raisins

RAISIN ROCK COOKIES Cream shortening Sift brown sugar and add grad-

ually Cream thoroughly and add beaten eggs. Sift flour, salt, soda, cloves and cinnamon together. All to the creamed mixture alternately with the sour milk until all are well blended. Add the chopped nuts and raisins. Drop by teaspoons about two inches apart onto a greased cookie sheet and bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees) 9 minutes. Makes about 100 2-inch cookies. These cookies will keep in a closed tin for several weeks.

- 1 6-ounce package semi-sweet chocolate bits
 - 1 14-oz. can (1 1/4 cups) sweetened condensed milk
 - Dash salt
 - 1 1/2 cups raisins
 - 1 1/2 cups coarsely chopped salted peanuts
- Melt chocolate bits over hot (not boiling) water. Blend in condensed milk and salt. Cook over rapidly boiling water till thickened, stirring constantly (about 10 min). Stir in raisins and nuts. Drop by rounded tablespoonfuls, 2 inches apart, onto foil-lined cookie sheet. Bake at 375 degrees for 10 minutes. Let stand till cold, then peel off foil. Yield. 32.
