Ruff milked an average of 65 pounds of butterfat and 1702 pounds of milk with a 3.8 per cent test from his four registered Holsteins.

Edwin J. Landis, Lancaster R7, with his herd of 31 mixed cows was in second place with 63 pounds of butterfat in 1,653 pounds of milk with a 3.8 per cent test.


A registered Holstein in the herd of Frank K. Book and Son, 11 South Hershey Ave., Bareville, completed the second high lactation with 693 pounds of butterfat in 16,989 pounds of milk with a 4.1 per cent test.

Only five other cows in the association completed their lactation during the month with more than 600 pounds of fat. They were in the herds of Ivan G. Martin, John H. Hershey, Mrs. Dorothy Chapman, John J. Oberholtzer, and Elam W. Mull.

Two other herds finished the month with average 60 pounds of fat or more during the period. In addition to the Ruff and Book herds, the herd of Titus Hurst and the herd of Leonard and Louise Witmer made better than the average. Hurst milks 20 registered and grade Holsteins while Witmer has 44 registered Guernseys.

A total of 31 herds in the association produced over 100,000 pounds of butterfat during the month
