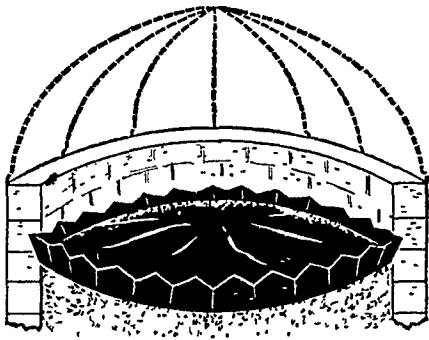

WILD FIRE CONTROL

BORDEAUX MIXTURE

Used as a wet spray, 4 lbs makes 50 gals. of spray. Two applications are needed when plants are small.

Use as a spray on tobacco plants against blue mold. Can be used with insecticides. Use 4 lbs to 100 gallons of water.

THE JAY LANDIS FARMSTEAD IS A REAL SHOWPLACE along the Conestoga creek. The well kept buildings and grounds reflect the management of the farm operator. A herd of 24 registered Holsteins on the farm have gone from an average of 432 pounds of butterfat per cow per year to 517 pounds in the past four years. —L F P

ing Holsteins forms the major part of the income producing power on the farm, but about six acres are reserved for tobacco.

This year Jay is raising his own plants from the newly developed Pennleaf -1 and Pennbel - 69 seed stocks. Plants will be ready for transplanting soon, but cool weather has held them back somewhat

Landis believes in a good forage program for his cows. He harvests about 15 acres of alfalfa hay and about the same amount of clover. "I think a cow gets tired of the same kind of hay all the time," he said. Last winter he fed the cows hay as many

as five times a day in addition to two feedings of corn silage per day.

Even with the cows on lush pasture at present, they need some high quality silage per day. (Turn to page 7)

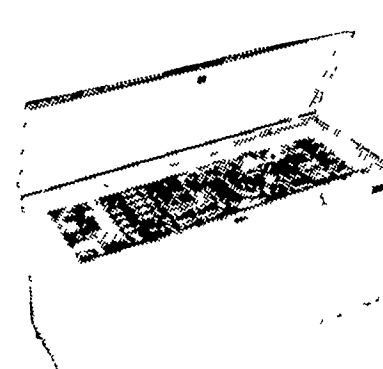
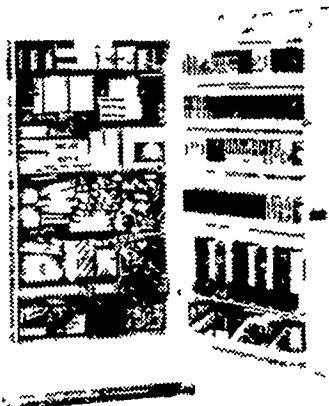
