

At Lancaster Yards Steady To 25 Higher

CATTLE: 3700 compared with 2184 last week. Supply included 60 percent slaughter steers and 30 percent stockers and feeders. Trading moderately active. Slaughter steers were steady to 25 higher on Monday but absent after Monday. Cows grading Utility 25 lower, Cutters steady, Canners 25 higher. Bulls steady. Stockers steady.

Slaughter Steers: The bulk of the Choice 950-1350 lbs. 23.75-25.00, several loads 1150-1350 lbs. high-Choice & Prime 25.25, load 1102 lbs. mostly Prime 25.50, Good to low-Choice 22.50-23.75, Standard 21.00-22.25.
