

At Lancaster Yards Heavies Feel Pressure

Cattle: 3750. Compared to 3735 last week. Supply included 60 per cent slaughter steers, 30 per cent stockers and feeders. Trading was slow. Slaughter steers 50 to 75 lower, spots 1.00 lower on weights over 1,250 pounds. Cows, bulls and stockers and feeders steady.

Bulk of the choice grade 1000 to 1,300 lb. slaughter steers 23-24. One load high choice 1,150 lb. steers, 24.50. A few loads at 1200 to 1300 lbs. 22.50-23.

A few lots of average to high choice heifers at 900 to 950 lbs 23.25. Two lots good 925-995 lb. 19.50-20.

Cutter and utility cows at 17.50-18.50. Canners and low cutters 16-17.50. Shelly canners down to 13.25.

Utility and commercial bulls 19.50-22.50. Good grade 22-23.50. A few to 24.

Good and choice 800-1050 lb. feeder steers 22.50-25. Medium and good 20.50-24.50.

Good and choice 550-800 lb. stock steers 24-27. Several lots 400 to 500 lb. stock

calves 26-27. CALVES: 500 compared to 665 last week. Trading was moderately active. Vealers weak. Good to choice vealers 28-33. Choice and prime 33-35 with a few to 36. Standard and low good 24-28 with utility at 22-24.

HOGS: 1400 compared to 1,818 last week. Trading was moderately active. Barrows and gilts 25 lower. Sows steady. U.S. 1-2 grade 190 - 220 lb. at 18.75-19.50. No. 1 at 190-220 lbs. 19.50-20. 1-3 grade 190-230 lbs. 19.25-18.50. 2-3 grade 230-250 lbs. 17.25-18. Sows 12-14.

SHEEP: 550 compared to 654 last week. Trading slow. Spring slaughter lambs at 16-18. Choice and prime at 18-20.

Don't wait until a field turns green with quackgrass before going over it again with a field cultivator, warns George Berggren, Penn State extension agronomist. Cultivate the field often enough so the roots can't get established.

Vintage Livestock Heavy Steers Feel Pressure

Cattle receipts totaled 466 at the June 13 auction at Vintage. Fills evident in most slaughter steers. Compared with last week's market slaughter steers 50-1.00 lower with weights over 1200 lbs; 75-1.00 lower. Cows steady. Bulls 50-1.00 lower.

Bulk of the Choice grade slaughter steers 950-1200 lbs. 22.75-24.00, few high-Choice 24.10-24.35, several lots 1200-1300 lbs. 22-22.75. Good to low-Choice 21.25-22.50, Standard 19.50-21.00.

Cutter and Utility cows 17.50 18 25, Canners and low-Cutters 16.00-17.50, shelly canners down to 13.00. Utility and Commercial bulls 19-22.50.

CALVES: 240, Vealers weighing 130 lbs. and heavier 2.00 lower. Lighter weights steady to 1.00 lower. Good and Choice vealers 32-00, Choice and Prime 32.00-34.50, Standard & low-Good 24.00-27.00, Utility down to 21.00.

HOGS: 211. Barrows and gilts 50-75 lower. U.S. 1 and 2 grade 194-220 lb. barrows and gilts 18.10-18.85, mostly (Turn to page 8)

New Holland Lower Grades Are Lower

Receipts at the June 15 auction at New Holland included 1099 cattle. Compared with last week's market slaughter steers grading average good and better, steady. Low good and below at 50 lower. Cows and bulls steady.

Choice grade slaughter steers weighing 950 to 1,200 pounds 23 24 with a few lots 24.10-24.50. 1,200 to 1,300 pound steers grading at choice were 22-23. Good to low choice 21.50-23 with standard down to 19.50.

A few lots good to low choice 750 860 pound heifers 20.50-21.10.

Cutter and utility cows made 17.50-18.25. Canners and low cutters 16-17.50 with shelly canners down to 13.50.

Utility and commercial bulls 20-23.10. A lot of choice 610 pound stock steers calves 26.50. A lot of good at 588 pounds 23.50 and a lot of choice 570 lb.

heifers at 20. Calves: 290. Vealers steady. Good and choice vealers 28-34. Standard and low good 24-28. Utility 23-26

At the June 14 sale dairy cattle all kinds were active and at steady prices. Receipts included 103 cows, eight stock bulls, and 14 stock heifers.

Fresh Holsteins brought \$300-445 while Guernsey made \$175-250 and other breeds sold at \$175-230. Bulls brought \$75-210 and heifers \$50-140.

All mules continued to the killer trade at the June 12 auction of horses. The market continued steady. Receipts of 293 head crossed the block.

Pony mares made \$85 160 while geldings brought \$55-140. Riding horses sold for \$135-275 and driving horses brought \$135-340. Killers made 9 1/2 to 10 cents.

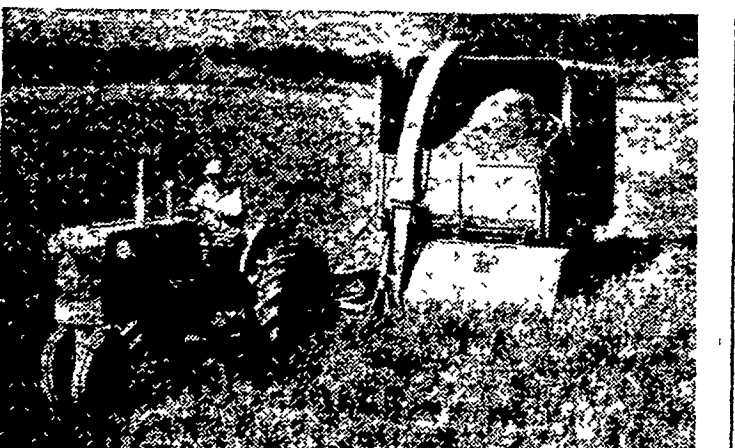
