Prices Up About A Cent

Broiler prices at the Lancaster Poultry Center climbed almost a cent a pound over the record low of last week when 94,300 broilers in 20 lots sold for 13.6 to 15 for an average of 14.35.

Heavy fowl brought 14.4, turkeys 19.1, roasters 20 and Cornish Game fowl 9.7 and 10.1 at the June 15 auction.

The complete sale offered 2,885 head in 34 lots and 104,785 head in 27 lots. Following is the complete listing with lot number, seller, power in parenthesis, amount and breed, age in wks., and days, buyer and price.

Prices Gain Movement Good

Delmarva reported prices of 13.20 to 14.20 on 786,700 head at farms during the 24 hour period ending at 10:30 Friday morning.

Live offerings were generally adequate and clearing well. Slightly higher average prices were noted.

Estimated slaughter by Eastern Shore processors for the week end is 868,300 head compared to the 911,000 last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending June 9 was down one point from the previous week at 2.7. Broilers averaged 12.75 per pound and mash cost \$95.42 per ton.

Milk Production Declines Noted

Production of fluid milk along the eastern seaboard declined slightly during the week. Supplies throughout the northeast continued fully ample and movement of surplus heavy but not as burdensome as last week.
