## State To Report Sweet Corn Sales

Harrisburg, Special reports of prices for sweet corn, tomatoes and cabbage at eastern Pennsylvania shipping points will be repeated this summer, the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture announced today.

John L. Rainey, director of the Bureau of Markets, said, "A trial run last season provided information on which can be used again this year. As grower-shippers watch the new reports and compare them with last year's pattern, they can adjust their shipping schedules to smooth out supply cycles."

Brattleboro, Vt.—A registered Holstein cow owned by Penna. State University, University Park, has shattered an all-time Pennsylvania butterfat record in the official Herd Testing programs of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America.

Penstate Reflection Josie May 4505705 (VG) established a new high for Junior 2-year-olds milked two times daily. Her official 365-day production totalled 18,595 lbs. of milk and 797 lbs. of butterfat.

The new record was made under the rules of Herd Improvement Registry—one of two herd-testing programs conducted by the Holstein Association. The second program is known as Dairy Herd Improvement Registry.
