**Broilers Show Life Gains**

Broilers showed a little gain at Lancaster this week as 39,700 head in 16 lots changed hands at prices ranging from 14 1/2 to 15 1/2 per pound. The average of 14 7/8 was paid for the 1440 last week. However, the gain was overcome the drop in price a cent a pound suffered last week. On July 6 auction at the Poultry Center sold four lots of broilers at 18 1/2 to 20 1/2 per pound. The 2700 head and four lots of pullets for 18 1/2 to 19 1/2 per pound. One lot of 2950 head. One lot of heavy fowl brought 100 males in one lot for 9 1/2. The complete sale offered 10 head in 31 lots and 46,650 head in 26 lots. A lot of 25,000 White Van-derbilt's not sold were 14 1/2. **Slaughter Up Prices Stronger**

Delmarva reported live poultry offerings in relatively good balance with processing need. Ready to cook demand improved generally and mostly fair to good at unchanged to fractionally higher delivered prices. Prices reported at farms ranged 13 70 to 14 60 on 805-600 head during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 on Friday morning. Estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week end was 1,025,000 head compared to the 851,000 head last week end. The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on June 30 was steady at 3 1 when broilers averaged 14 50 per pound and mash cost \$92 60 per ton. The ratio of the comparable week a year earlier was 4 1 when broilers made 18 72 and mash cost the grower \$91 65 per ton.
