ge League Federation showing increased grain feeding caused a production increase on 95 per cent of the cows tested, but only 45 per cent of the cows which responded made profitable gains.

The Cowculator was developed by Dr. C. D. Caskey, director of feed research for Cooperative Mills, Inc., owned by five farmer cooperatives including Pennsylvania Farm Bureau. Rights for the electronic device are controlled by P.F.B. and the Southern States Cooperative. Kish and McCormick told the gathering about 560 farm people that service is available on first come, first served basis. However, farmers interested in using the device should keep accurate production and feed cost records.

Lancaster branch office manager C. P. Brantley reported that S.P.A.B.C. is progressing at about 54 per cent ahead of one year ago. He said the Lancaster office has a gain of 10 per cent during June over 1960.

David Yoder, general manager, invited members to participate in the tenth annual S.P.A.B.C. Cattle show at Lancaster, August 1 and 3.
