Compared with last weeks close slaughter steers were steady on average choice and better and all grades weighing over 1,200 lbs, low Choice and below weighing under 1200 lbs. strong. Cows 25 higher. Bulls fully steady. Stockers and feeders steady.



Maneb Increases Potato Crop Value By 38% Over Nabam
