

Poultry Center Boiler Prices Easier

Boilers lost some of the heat of last week at the 10 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center. A total of 63,155 birds in 22 lots crossed the block at prices ranging from 147 to 150 for a sale average of 148.

Three lots of Leghorn broilers were sold at prices of 106 for the 2,125 birds, 107 for the 2,125 birds and 108 for the 2,125 birds. Three lots of pullets ranging from 5,400 head sold for 171 while 3,750 roasters sold for 171 to 172. One lot of 900 heavy made 136 and 40 males for 80 cents per pound. A complete sale offered 20 head in 41 lots and 95 370 head in 33 lots. Two lots of broilers not were bid to 144 and while bids ranging all way from 14 to 17 were bid for roasters. Delmarva - Georgia Clearing Well Prices Higher

Delmarva reported live broiler offerings clearing well at slightly higher average prices. Sales and reported prices during the 24 hr. period ending 10:30 Friday morning included 870,700 head at farms at prices ranging from 13¢ to 14¢ 80.

Current ready to cook movement continues light but mated slaughter by Delmarva processors for the week end was 736,000 head compared to the 674,000 of last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending August 4 was 3.2. This represents a jump of four points over the previous week when the ratio was 2.8. Broilers during the period averaged 2.9 per lb. and mash cost the grower \$94.77 per ton. The ratio for the corresponding week last year was 4.0 when broilers averaged 18.04 and mash cost \$90.63 per ton.
