

Poultry Center Broilers In Nosedive

Broiler prices plummeted a half at the Poultry Center week almost erasing all gain of two weeks ago. The August 17 auction of 14 lots of broilers in 14 lots brought prices of 13 to 15.3 average of 13.48 compared with the 14.96 last week.

The lot of 1,300 pullets brought 19.2 while three including 1,900 roasters brought 18.1 to 18.6. A total of 700 heavy fowl in two lots ranged from 8.3 to 9.9 the 1,050 head, and 500 or cross cockerels in two lots made 15 to 15.2.

The complete sale offered 25 head in 37 lots and 55-125 head in 26 lots. Six lots of broilers not were bid to 13.7 while birds on the five lots of old roasters ranged from 10 to 18.1.

Delmarva - Georgia Prices Down About 3/4 Cent

Live broiler prices in Delmarva were approximately 3/4 cent lower during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. The decline was a reflection of the lower prices in competing areas. Prices reported and sales made during the period ranged from 12.10 to 13.30 for 721,000 head at farms.

Offerings in Delmarva were ample for processing needs. Eastern shore processors estimated their slaughter for the week end at 830,000 head compared with the 736,000 last weekend.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on August 8 was down one point from the previous week. The ratio was 3.1 when broilers averaged 14.46 per pound and market cost \$94.32 per ton. This compares with the 3.8 ratio for the same week a year earlier and 4.2 six months ago.
