2 squares unsweetened chocolate  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 tablespoon butter  
1 small can evaporated milk

Melt chocolate; stir in sugar. Stir in butter; then add evaporated milk slowly. Cook until thickened, stirring constantly. Serve hot. Makes 6 to 8 servings.

**RAINBOW PARFAITS**

7-ounce package sugar wafers, crushed  
1 pint vanilla ice cream  
1 pint coffee ice cream  
1 pint raspberry sherbet  
Layer crushed sugar wafers, vanilla and coffee ice cream, and raspberry sherbet in four tall parfait glasses. Store in freezer until ready to serve. Serve with cream sandwich cookies.

**Food Summary  
Holiday Habits Overcome Logic**

Holiday habits are more important than economic logic this week-end as homemakers prepare for the traditional Labor Day outings and perhaps the season's last outdoor barbecue. Retailers will cater to the public's interest by including the popular hamburgers, hot dogs and potato chips in their merchandising plans, observes Tom Piper, Penn State Extension Marketing Agent.

Smoked picnics, smoked hams and sausages will join the vast array of table ready meats to be featured at economical prices this weekend. Small size turkeys and broiler-fryers remain in heavy supply and should prove economical. Beef will receive less promotional emphasis this week but steaks and boneless roasts are reasonably priced and may be considered as candidates for top spot on the menu.

Fresh fruits and vegetables from local growing areas are

available at roadside stands, farmers markets and your favorite foodmarket. Homemakers desiring to can or freeze supplies for use this winter would do well to shop for peaches, pruned-plums, green beans, lima beans, beets, sweet corn and tomatoes now. Cabbage, potatoes, yellow onions, lettuce, peppers, carrots, celery and cucumbers belong on the list of good buys at this season of the year.

This is the time of year when shoppers should price eggs by the pound rather than by the dozen to determine best value. Small eggs weigh 18 ounces to the dozen, medium 21 ounces and large eggs 24 ounces. If a dozen small eggs costs 33c as many do now, then they only cost 29c a pound. At that rate, mediums should cost 38 cents a dozen and large 44 cents, but actually they are costing considerably more. This method will give cost-conscious shoppers a sound basis for making egg price comparisons and will reveal the smaller sizes to offer the most for the money now.

The local peach harvest is nearing its peak. This popular fruit heads a list of seasonally abundant and reasonably priced items.
