Slaughter steers weighing under 1250 lb steady to 25 higher. Heavier wgt's steady. Cows, bulls, stockers and feeders steady. Load prime 1185 lb slaughter steers at 23 25, load 1303 lb prime 25 10, five loads high-choice to mostly prime 1025-1200 lb 26, choice 24-25 75, good to low-choice 22 75-24, standard 21-22 50.

New Holland Heavyweights Are Lower

Receipts included 1074 head of cattle at the September 8 auction at New Holland. Compared with last week's market, slaughter steers about steady with over 1300 lb 25 lower. Cows 25 higher. Bulls steady.

High-choice and prime 950-1215 lb. 25 85-26 50, Choice 23 75-25 75, several weighing up to 1400 lb 23 25, Good to low-Choice 22 50-24 00, Standard 21 00-22 50.

Cutter and Utility cows 15 50-16 50, Canners & low-Cutters 14 00-15 50, shelly canners down to 12 00. Utility and Commercial bulls 19-22 00.

Medium and Good 578-759 lb stock steers 20 75-24 00. Two lots Medium 850-931 lb. feeder steers 21 50-21 75.

CALVES: 453. Vealers fully steady to strong. Good and Choice vealers 27 00-33 00, Choice and Prime 33 00-38. Standard and low-Good 23 00-27 50, Utility 20 00-24 00 85-100 lb Utility 18-20.

Excellent harvest weather kept buyers in the fields during the Sept 6 auction of dairy cattle. A very slow market on the 193 cows, 3 bulls and nine heifers resulted with prices slightly softer than in previous weeks.

Fresh Holstein cows made \$300-450 with Guernseys bringing \$175-225 and other

breeds at \$175-320. Stock bulls sold for \$85-180 and stock heifers made \$45-140. The market continued steady at the September 4 sale of horses, ponies and mules. Receipts included 20 head.

Mare ponies brought \$90-145 and geldings made \$40-115. Riding horses crossed the block at \$110-225 while driving horses changed hands at \$110-300. Killer horses and mules brought 8 1/2 to 9 cents.

WEEKLY REVIEW CATTLE—Receipts reduced 20 per cent due to the loss of major marketing day Monday.

Slaughter steers choice and below 1200 lbs down steady to 25 lower but mostly steady. Most steers over 1200 lb steady to 50 lower with bulk of decline on choice 1200-1350 lb weights prime steers 50-100 lower. Heifers steady to 25 higher. Cows weak to 25 lower. Bulls steady to 25 lower.
