The veal calf market continues to grow rapidly at the Vintage sale stables. Receipts at the September 12 auction had a total of 600 head, up a full 100 head from last week. In spite of the heavy run, vealers were steady to 1 lower Good and choice vealers brought 27 to 33 with choice and prime at 33 to 37. Standard and low good were 23 to 27 and utility made 19 to 23.

Good harvest weather kept buyers in the fields again during the September 13 sale of dairy cattle. The market was slow and draggy on the 140 cows, two bulls and 15 stock heifers.

Fresh Holstein cows made \$300-440 while fresh Guernseys were \$175-225 and -oth-

er breeds \$175-285. Stock bulls brought \$140-175 and stock heifers were \$75-145. End of vacation had its effect on the horse market at the September 11 sale. All kinds were slow and lower with killers down about one cent Receipts included 24 head.

Mare ponies brought \$85 165 and geldings were \$45 120. Riding horses brought \$110-220 while driving horses sold for \$110-180. Killers brought 7½-8½ cents.

**Chicago Cattle Most Close To 50 Lower**
