**Gains Show On Lite Run**

Broiler prices were up a cent and a half a pound from the record low of the previous week at the September 14 auction at the Lancaster Poultry Center. Volume was relatively small and all lots on offer were sold. Prices on broilers ranged from 13.3 to 14.8 on 54,000 head in 12 lots for a sale average of 13.85. Sale average of the corresponding sale a year ago was 13.85.

Four lots of 4,450 pullets brought 19 to 19.8 while 1,175 straight run roasters made 17 to 18.1. Two lots of leghorn fowl brought 8.6 and 8.8 for the 1,025 head. The lot of 525 heavy fowl crossed the block at 12.1 sales were 7 cents.

The complete sale offered and sold a total of 63,230 birds in 21 lots. Following the complete sale with lot number, seller, grower in parenthesis, amount and the breed, age in weeks and buyer and price.

**KEEP EGGS CLEAN**  
Two or 3 inches of clean, dry shavings in nests in the laying house help prevent breakage and keep eggs clean, says F. H. Leuschner, Penn State extension poultry specialist. He also suggests frequent gathering of eggs, and wiring the droppings boards.

**Delmarva-Georgia Rices Weaker Supplies Ample**

Live broiler prices in the Delmarva growing area averaged approximately 1/2 cent lower during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Offerings were generally ample for the current processing needs. Eastern shore processors estimated slaughter for the week end at 783,000 head compared with the 909,000 head last week end.

Prices and reported sales at farms during the period ranged from 12 to 13.10 for 498 100 head.

Buying interest for next week's delivery was reported spotty with the supply of ready to cook poultry light to moderate.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on September 8 was unchanged from the previous week at 2-7. Broilers averaged 12.42 per pound and mash cost the grower \$93.50 per ton.

The ratio last year during the comparable week was 3.7 when broilers brought 17.05 per pound and mash cost \$91.82 per ton. The 3.7 ratio held until six months ago with broilers averaging 17.47 during that week.
