High choice and prime grade slaughter steers made 25 75 to 26 10 Choice were 24-25 60 with a few weighing over 1,350 pounds down to 23 Good to low choice made 22 50 to 24 Standard were 21-22 50.

Cutter and utility cows brought 16-17 25. Canners & low cutters made 14 50-16 25 with shelly canners down to 12 50

Utility and commercial bulls were 19 50-22 with good grade up to 23 50.

One lot of good 660 pound stock steers brought 22.35. Several loads and lots of good to low choice 752-950 pound feeder steers brought 22-24 50

Mare ponies made \$75-110 and geldings were \$40-110 Riding horses crossed block at \$110-190 and driving horses changed hands, \$110-250 Killer horses and mules were 7 to 8 cents
