Chicken Specials

Now, when chicken is so often featured as a special at food stores, is the time to try some special chicken recipes. Too often we rely on the old favorites and thus pass up some delicious eating because we are reluctant to try new flavor combinations or new methods of cooking.

Too often a recipe is passed by because the name sounds too exotic. It is a good idea to look over the list of ingredients before deciding whether you might like to try it or not. You do not know what you might be missing!

BAKED CHICKEN WITH BUTTERMILK BISCUITS

- 1/2 cup flour
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
- 2 (2 1/2-lb) fryer chickens, quartered
- 1/2 cup butter or margarine
- 1 (10-oz) can cream of celery soup
- 1 (7-oz) bottle lemon-lime

buttermilk biscuits.

Combine flour, salt, pepper and parmesan cheese in a paper bag. Add chicken pieces, a few at a time, and shake bag to coat chicken thoroughly. Melt butter in bottom of baking pan (9x13-x2"). Arrange chicken, skin side down, in pan. Bake at 425 degrees for 30 minutes, then turn chicken and bake for 15 to 20 minutes longer. Combine soup with lemon-lime carbonated beverage & 1/2 cup parmesan cheese. Pour over chicken. Arrange refrigerator biscuits around chicken. Bake at 450 degrees for 12 to 15 minutes longer or until biscuits are browned. Makes 4 servings.

- 1/2 cup grated parmesan cheese

GOLDEN CRUNCHY OVEN FRIED CHICKEN
2 1/2 to 3 pound frying chicken

- ken, cut up
- 1 stick (1/2 cup) butter or margarine
- 1/2 cup evaporated milk or light cream
- 1 cup crushed corn flakes
- 1/4 cup finely chopped onion
- 1/4 cup finely chopped parsley
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1/2 teaspoon marjoram

Melt butter in a shallow 13 by 9 inch baking dish in a hot oven (400 degrees). Dip chicken pieces in milk and

roll in corn flake crumbs. Arrange chicken in the baking dish skin side down. Cover the top or the chicken with the remaining ingredients. Bake in a hot oven (400 degrees) for about twenty minutes. Turn chicken. Bake another 20 to 30 minutes or until chicken is tender. Serve immediately or, serve cold at a picnic or patio party.
