in county beef, swine, and beekeeping clubs. He was chosen to represent the state 4-H in Washington, D. C.

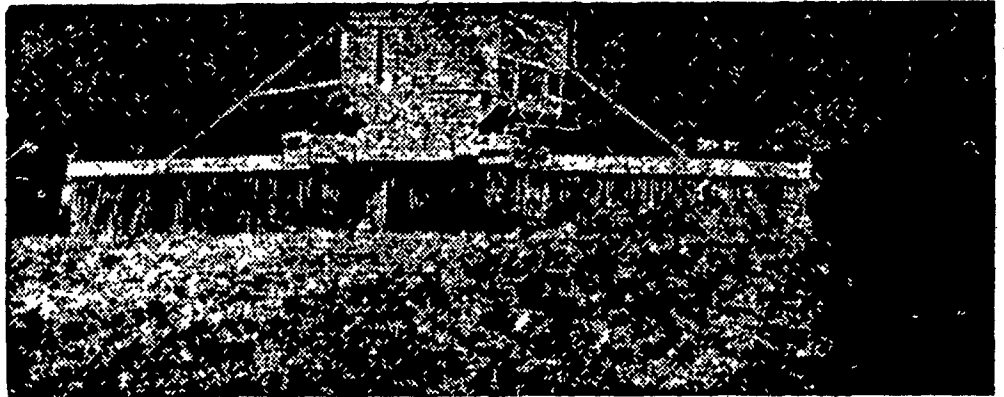

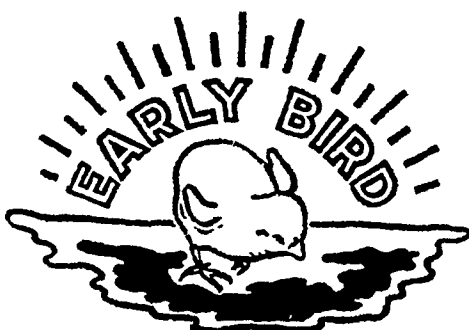
