

Lanc. Poultry Center Broilers Exhibit Strength

Broilers gained a little strength this week at the Lancaster Poultry Center as 71,300 head in 20 lots crossed the block at prices ranging from 13.6 to 14.0 for a sale average of 13.83. At the corresponding sale last year broilers averaged 17.11.

Three lots containing 4-950 pullets brought 17.4 to 17.8 while one lot of 2,000 roasters changed hands at 18.0. A total of 3,300 leghorn fowl in two lots brought 9.0 and 9.7.

Broilers Down Supply Ample

Delmarva reported prices of 12 to 13.7 on 837,300 head at farms during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Broiler prices averaged approximately 1/2 cent lower during the period.

Offerings were increased and were generally ample for processing needs. Estimated slaughter by Eastern Shore processors for the week end was 762,000 head compared to the 694,000 head last ween end.

The De'marva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending October 6, was down four points from the previous week at 2.8. Broilers averaged 12.61 per pound and mash cost the grower \$89.97 per ton. During the comparable week a year ago the ratio was 3.6 when broilers averaged 15.87 per pound and mash was \$87.85 per ton.

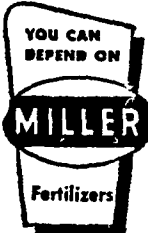
