7. Resolved—That the by-laws of the county be amended that no associate member can serve on a committee or act as spokesman for the association.

10. Resolved — That Social Security taxes should not be increased to pay medical costs for any portion of the population.

11. Resolved — That small game season not be opened before first Saturday in November.

12. Resolved — That rodent bombs be legalized for the elimination of rodents.

14. Resolved — We oppose House Bill No. 1151. (A bill to authorize township supervisors to cut in streets and access roads without the vote of the electorate.)

13. Resolved— That farmers be included on juries for the purpose of appraising condemned land for highways.

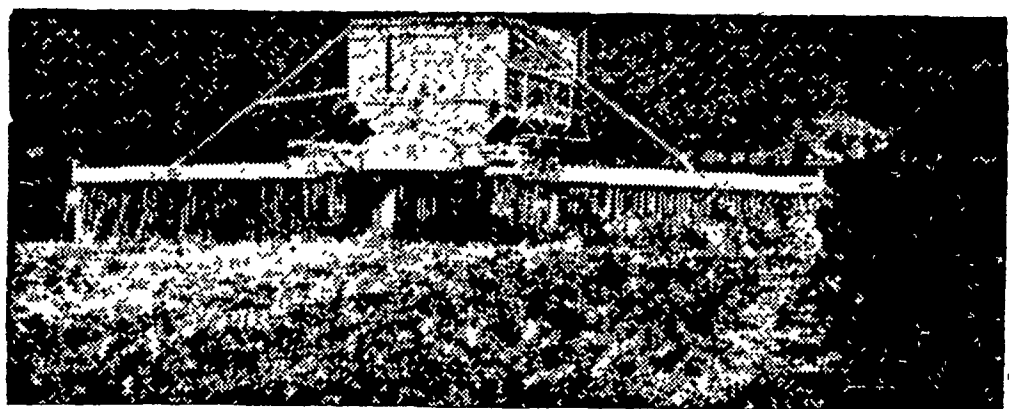

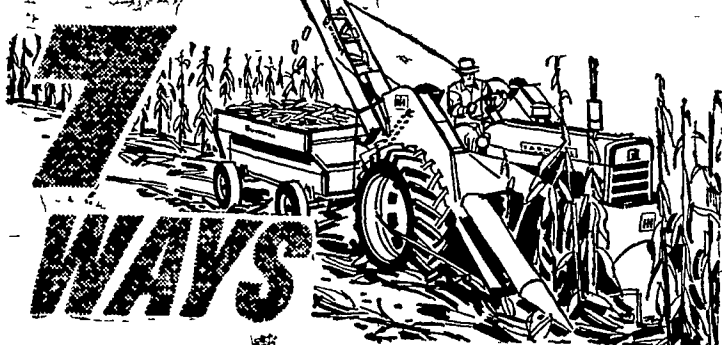
