disposal of the present building

During the discussion Poultry Association member, Lewis Mortensen asked what sort of commitment the Agriculture Center board expected from the poultrymen

After reviewing a list of six recommendations drawn up at a joint meeting of the Poultry Association directors and the Agriculture Center board, Levi Brubaker, finance committee chairman for

the Agriculture Center said the Poultrymen would have no financial obligation above rental of facilities in the proposed building. He reminded poultrymen, however, that they do have a moral obligation to the contributors toward the present Poultry Center.

At present time, the Poultry Center, constructed in 1957 at an approximate cost of \$67,000, carries a mortgage of slightly more than \$18,000 While the Center

has been operating at a profit it was pointed out that recent developments in the poultry industry and declining numbers of poultry listed on the exchange sale have cut the margins and made reduction of the building debt extremely slow.

Members Thursday night expressed belief that the best interests of the poultry as well as agriculture throughout the county could best be served if operations were moved to the central location.

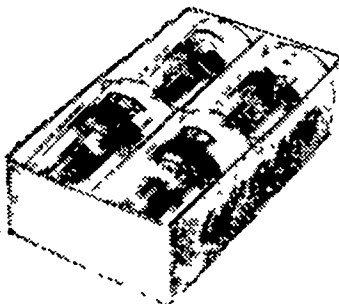

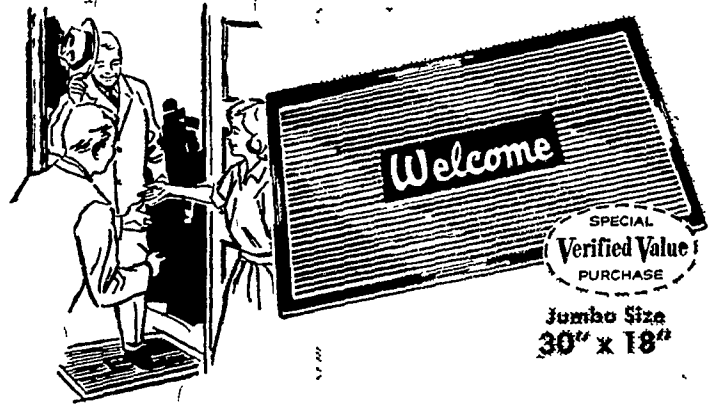

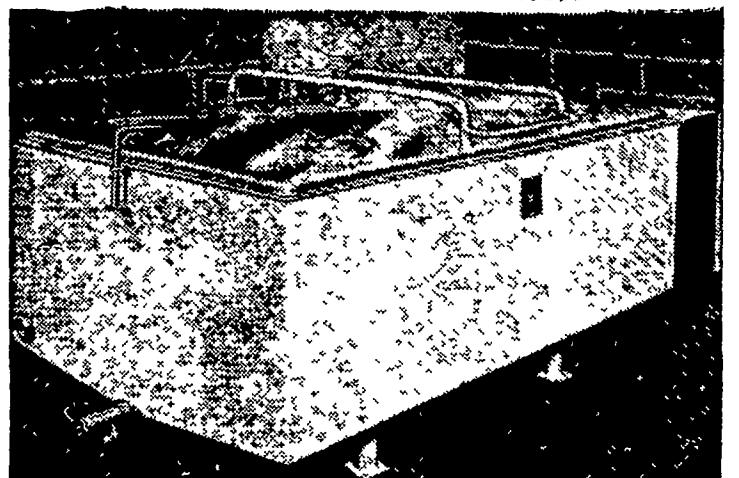
