# Broilers Continue Climb

Broilers continued to gain some ground at the Poultry Center this week as 53,000 head in 14 lots changed hands at prices ranging from 14.8 to 15.3 for a sale average of 14.96. The average at the October 19 auction was the highest sale average since Sept. 23 when broilers made a 15.23 average. Broilers at the corresponding sale a year ago brought a 17.09 average.

One lot of 900 pullet roasters brought 20.6 while five lots of cockerel roasters including 3,725 head changed hands at 20.5 to 21.7. Three lots of 5,100 leghorn fowl sold for 8.5 to 8.7. One lot of 1,150 heavy fowl made 13.2 and 100 males brought 7.2.

The complete auction offered and sold 63,975 head in 25 lots. The sale marked the first time since May 13 that all birds on offer were sold.

## Delmarva - Georgia

### Broilers Gain About One Cent

Delmarva reported prices were approximately one cent higher during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning. Prices of 13 to 15 on 695,800 head were reported.

Supplies were moderate to short of the increased demand. With most of the eastern shore processors not operating today the estimated slaughter for the week end was 835,900 head compared with 949,000 head last week-end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on October 13 was 2.9 as broilers averaged 12.88 per pound and 20% mash cost the grower \$88.95 per ton. The ratio for the corresponding week a year ago was 3.8 when broilers averaged 16.50 and mash cost \$86.80 per ton.
