- Opposition to national air trade policies.
  - Retention of sanitation measures now handled by the Agriculture Department within the department, rather than transfer them to the health Department.
  - A study of Vocational Agriculture education program
  - Assessment of agriculture land used for farming or other agriculture solely on the basis of 'such use.
  - All able bodied persons on public assistance be put to work in the counties in which they reside.
  - Relief be denied persons on public assistance who refuse reasonable job opportunities
  - Social security for the self employed be made optional.
  - Lowering the permissible bacteria content in milk.
- A resolution that the Milk Control Commission abolish seasonal pricing was rejected by the membership.
- In other business, G. A. Biggs of Fulton County was reelected president and named delegate to the national convention of the American Farm Bureau Federation

next month. John Phillips of Erie County was named as alternate delegate.  
 Other officers elected were Paul Anthony, Berks County, vice president, and an executive committee composed of Paul Lerew, Adams County; Russ Vosburgh, Crawford County; and J. Carl Empie of Chester County.
