

# Most Broilers Not Sold

Broiler growers expressed reluctance to accept the average price of 12.53 cents per pound at the Lancaster Poultry Center this week. Seven lots of birds containing 49,700 head were withdrawn at bids of 11.6 to 12.6.

Only four lots of broilers changed hands. These four lots contained only 11,875 head and brought prices of 12.4 to 13.1.

Three lots of 8,050 leghorn fowl brought 7.9 to 8.5 while 550 heavy fowl made 14.2.

A total of 2,500 roasters in four lots brought 20.9 to 22.1. Two lots containing 1,500 pullets made 22.6 to 24.5.

The complete November 16 auction offered 75,210 head in 23 lots and sold 24,510 birds in 15 lots.

# Prices About 1 Cent Higher

Delmarva reported prices approximately one cent higher during the 24 hour period ending 10:30 Friday morning largely due to the lighter offerings and an increased demand.

Prices of 12.40 to 13.70 for 460,200 head at farms were reported.

Demand is generally very quiet with practically no processors operating Saturday. Estimated slaughter for the week end is 525,000 head compared with the 735,000 head last weekend.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on Nov 10 reflected the fractionally higher broiler price of the week. The ratio moved from 2.7 the previous week to 2.8 as broilers averaged 12.51 and mash cost the grower \$89.14 per ton. The ratio for the comparable week a year ago was 4.1 when broilers averaged 17.63 and mash cost \$86.60 per ton.


