

Holiday Postpones Sale

Because of the Thanksgiving holiday, the auction sale at the Lancaster Poultry center was postponed this week from Thursday to Friday. Sale reports were unavailable at press time.

Delmarva - Georgia Demand Better Prices Gain

Delmarva reported broiler prices during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning approximately 1/4 cent higher as the demand continued to improve, although offerings were moderate.

Prices of 12 90 to 13.70 on 687,500 head at farms were reported during this period.

Processors appeared optimistic for next week with the estimated slaughter for the week end going to 772,800 head compared with the 525,000 head last week end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending Nov 17 was down one point from the previous week at 2.7 Broilers averaged 12 22 per pound and mash cost the grower \$90 12 per ton

The ratio for the comparable week a year ago was 3.8 when broilers averaged 16 29 per pound and mash cost \$86 52 per ton Six months ago the ratio had dropped to 3.1 as broilers fell to 15 01 and mash rose to \$95 80 per ton.
