

Lanc. Poultry Center Broilers Continue Climb

Broilers were on the upgrade for the second week in a row at the Lancaster Poultry Center this week. At the November 30 auction a total of 37,500 broilers crossed the block at prices of 14.25 to 16.5 for a sale average of 14.76. Only one lot of 3,000 white vantage at 9 weeks, two days, failed to move at the bid of 14.0. All other birds on offer changed hands.

Eight lots of roasters containing 7,675 head sold at prices of 21 to 24. Three lots containing 2,075 pullets made 26.5 to 28.2 and 500 heavy fowl brought 15.8.

The complete sale offered 50,750 head in 22 lots and sold 47,750 head in 21 lots. Following is the complete sale with lot number, seller, grower in parenthesis, amount and breed, age in weeks and days, buyer and price.

Delmarva-Georgia Prices Gain About A Cent

Delmarva reported prices about a cent higher during the 24 hour period ending at 10:30 Friday morning as demand increased to a good position despite moderately heavy offerings.

Processors indicated that weights were running much heavier than desired. Estimated slaughter for the week end was 851,000 head compared with 773,000 head last week end.

Prices of 13.50 to 14.60 on 822,400 head at farms were reported during the period.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending on November 24 was up two points from the previous week at 2.9. Broilers averaged 13.33 per pound and mash cost the grower \$92.38 per ton. The two points gain in the ratio was a reflection of the gain in broiler prices from the 12.22 of the previous week, but mash also rose from the \$90.12 per ton of the previous week.

For the comparable week a year ago, the ratio stood at 3.6 when broilers averaged 15.51 and mash sold for \$86.37 per ton.

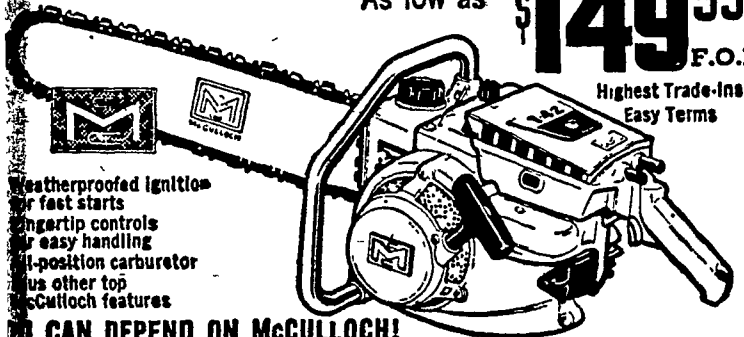
