The new standards-all of well as non-farm constructlity trailers, and minature automobiles.

A key provision of the new regulation states that every required lamp musi be lighted by electricity supplied by a wet-cell storage battery or by an electrical generating system or both. The new standards require that animal-drawn vehicles including buggies be

equipped with pairs of reflectors and hazard warning ¹°mps on the front and rear. The lamps must be capable of flashing simultaneously.

A double faced hazard light or directional signal located on each side of the vehicle can be substituted for the two pairs of front and rear lamps.


Combine Effort Young Farmers Are Advised

State College, Nov. 29 -Pennsylvania's Deputy Secretary of Agriculture today chided the state's farm organzations for "cancelling out any major effectiveness by cetty quarreling among your-'elves.

Speaking before the annual convention of the Penny vania Young Farmers Asciation, D Richard Wenner hallenged the delegates to ake the lead in "turning organization vigor to common problems rather than fighting mong themselves This lack of unity is evident both in Harri burg and Washington," Wenner said

In addition to "unity" Wenner listed four other major needs of agriculture: leaders, foresightedness, realism and economic bargaining power.

"We must face the fact that we no longer have great political strength," Wenner said.


