**SUGARED CHRISTMAS BELLS**

1/2 cup shortening  
1 1/2 cups sugar  
1 teaspoon salt  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
2 eggs  
1 1/2 cups sifted flour  
1/2 teaspoon soda  
2 teaspoons baking powder  
1/2 cup dairy soured cream

**Raisin Filling**  
Sugar  
Cream shortening well. Add 1 1/2 cups sugar gradually with salt and vanilla. Continue creaming. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Sift flour with soda and baking powder and stir into shortening mixture. Add sour cream. Mix well. Chi'l. Roll out on a lightly floured board or pastry cloth. Cut with a bell-shaped cutter

**CHRISTMAS JEWEL DROPS**  
2 1/4 cups sifted enriched flour  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1 cup butter or margarine  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 teaspoon vanilla extract  
1 cup finely cut or chopped gumdrops  
1 cup flaked coconut (3 1/2 ounce can)  
Sift together flour and salt. Cream butter or margarine, sugar and vanilla extract until light and fluffy. Blend dry ingredients into creamed mixture. Add gumdrops and coconut M x well. Drop dough by teaspoonfuls on greased baking sheet. Bake in slow oven (325 degrees) 15 to 20 minutes. Makes about 60 cookies.

1/2 teaspoon salt  
3/4 cup butter or margarine  
1 cup confectioners' sugar  
2 eggs, separated  
1 teaspoon vanilla extract  
1/2 cup flaked coconut  
1/4 cup red raspberry preserves  
Dash salt  
1/2 cup confectioners' sugar  
Sift together flour and salt. Cream butter or margarine with 1 cup sugar until light and fluffy. Add egg yolks and vanilla extract. Beat well. Blend in flour gradually, stirring to make a smooth dough. Add coconut and mix thoroughly. Drop dough by tablespoonfuls on ungreased baking sheet. Make a depression in the center of each cookie and fill with preserves (Turn to page 8)

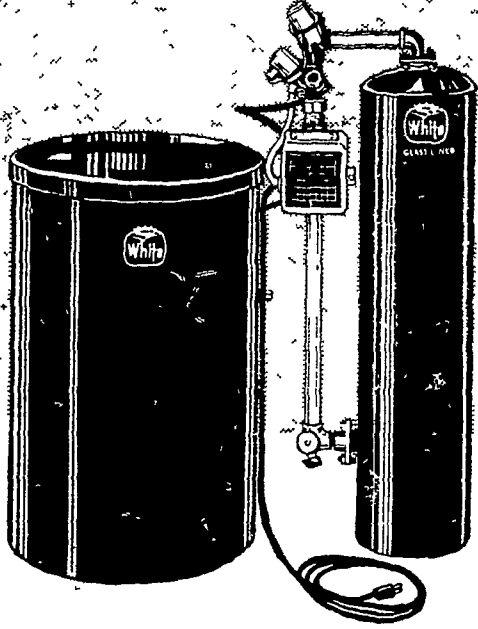
