and two went to new owners at \$520 each. The top grade cow in the

sale brought \$580. Other grade cows were bid in at \$485 and \$460 with several head going over \$400. A total of 37 cows and first calf heifers were sold along with 28 head of younger stock.

Mixed alfalfa hay brought \$32.50 per ton. Feed carts sold for \$80 and \$72.50 and three milker units brought \$72.50 each. A 375 gallon bulk milk tank sold for \$1080 and a thermostatically controlled ventilation fan brought \$152.50. Diller and Kreider were the auctioneers.
