the frost got them" he said, but now the fruits ripen over a shorter period

Manure from the 26 steers he feeds was applied to the tomato ground at the rate of about 10 tons per acre and about 750 pounds of 0-15-30 was plowed down. Another 450 pounds of 5-10-10 was broadcast and worked into the soil. When the plants were transplanted into the field, a starter solution of 8-50-20 was put on with the water. A solution was also included to repel wireworms

Mylin put on a mixture of insecticide spray and fungicide about four weeks after planting and followed with fungicide about every ten days all through the growing season

We plow about as deep as the top soil goes, Mylin said, and the ground is worked down with disc and cultipacker entirely. "I don't own a sprungtooth harrow any more," he said. The crop last year got four cultivations. The first cultivation is about as deep as we can go, but after that we use a 'duckfoot' or sweep tooth on the cultivator and

don't go as deep" he said

All the picking is done by migrant laborers. "I have tried other methods of getting the tomatoes picked, but I wouldn't try to raise tomatoes any more without the migrants," Mylin said

In addition to tomatoes, Mylin grows eight acres of tobacco, corn, grain and hay to feed his 26 head of steers. He keeps about 500 laying hens which he purchases ready for the laying house

A total of 118 growers in 22 counties averaged 20 or more tons per acre to qualify

for the master growers award.

In master growers Lancaster county led with 27. Columbia had 22 and Franklin, 19. The others Chester and Lebanon, 7 each; Erie, 5, York, 4; Lehigh, Berks, Bucks and Snyder, 3 each; Cumberland, Adams, Union and Schuylkill, 2 each; Lycoming, Montour, Northumberland, Northampton, Montgomery, Bedford and Dauphin, 1 each
