

## Angus Show, Sale Scheduled

Steadily increasing interest in the breeding of beef cattle in Pennsylvania is expected to attract several Lancaster County farmers to the second annual Eastern Angus Association Futurity and open show and sale on Wednesday and Thursday, Feb. 21 and 22, in the small arena of the Farm Show building in Harrisburg.

Lancaster County will be represented by Frey's Twin Oak Farms, Quarryville R2 with a bull of the well known Eileenmere blood line.

More than 100 young pure bred Angus bulls and cows have been consigned by 31 breeders from six states, 15 located in Pennsylvania. Other breeders showing are from Virginia, Maryland, New Jersey, New York and Connecticut. Many animals entered are offspring of champion and reserve champion winners at the International Pennsylvania, Eastern and other Livestock expositions.

Eisenhower Farms of Gettysburg will be represented with three pedigreed females two in the Futurity and one in the open show. Other Southeastern Pennsylvania Angus breeding farms sending pedigreed stock include Reynard Run Farm, Downingtown; Millarden Farms, Annville; Soleil Farms and Cloud Valley Farms, Pottstown, and Robinwood Farm, Camp Hill.

The Futurity and open shows will be judged by Dr. Robert A. Long, University

of Georgia, starting at 10 a.m. Feb. 21. Individual class awards and championship trophies will be presented. All animals are to be sold. The Angus sale on Feb.

22 is intended to attract small breeders by offering the best quality at reasonable prices, according to Dr. Dean L. Snyder, Annville, secretary-treasurer of the Eastern Angus Association. Breeders from eight North-

eastern states formed the association with the idea of their time and skills so that selling purebred Angus breeding stock on a cooperative price, that most interested people can afford to pay.

¼ teaspoon nutmeg	¼ cup butter or margarine

In lightly buttered shallow casserole, arrange layer of sweet potato slices; cover with apple sauce and sprinkle with nutmeg. Arrange frankfurters on top of apple sauce with remainder of potato slices. Sprinkle with salt and dot with butter. Bake in a moderate oven, 350 degrees for 25 to 30 minutes. Makes 6 servings.
