Apples remain in plentiful supply. Economy-minded shoppers would do well to place less emphasis on the color of

apples, more on condition, if interested in quality. Grapefruit offers good value and lower orange prices, are in prospect in the next few weeks. First-of-season Valencias, seedless and very juicy, are now appearing at local

markets. Supplies of Temple and Murcott oranges are ample and a good choice for eating out-of-hand.

Banana prices remain steady as importers schedule shipments to satisfy consumer demand. Somewhat lower prices are in prospect for pineapples as larger shipments arrive from Florida.

Meat supplies remain ample and shoppers are reminded to check newspaper advertisements for featured items. The low-price-season for pork cuts should continue until April and heavy supplies of beef cattle assure ample offerings of ground beef, steaks and chuck roasts.

be very plentiful and the best buy in poultry, although prices for frying chickens are gradually dropping. Eggs and all dairy products are economical choices for supplies of these items are abundant.
