

Price Firm On Big Run

Volume rose on the Lancaster Poultry Exchange this week with very little effect on prices.

Twenty three lots of broilers change hands at prices of 18 5 to 20 8. The 121,075 head sold for a sale average of 18 71. Two lots of broilers containing 27,500 head did not sell at the bids of 18 4 and 18 5.

One other lot on offer failed to sell. The 2,200 heavy fowl were bid to 19 3.

Two lots of 1,250 roasters brought 29 8 to 30 1 and two lots of 1,350 pullets sold for 27 1 to 28 1. One lot of 825 heavy fowl brought 18 8 to 19 0. Sixty males made 8 5.

The complete March 1 auction offered 154,500 head in 34 lots and sold 124,560 head in 31 lots.

Delmarva - Georgia Prices Down About 1 1/4 Cent

Delmarva reported live broiler prices averaged approximately 1 1/4 cent lower during the 24 hour period ending 10 30 Friday morning.

Prices of 17 3 to 19 1 for 796,600 head at farms were reported.

A barely fair demand for the moderate supplies showed buyers are still resistant to prices.

Estimated slaughter by eastern shore processors for the week-end was 751,000 head compared with 796,000 head last week-end.

The Delmarva broiler-feed ratio for the week ending February 23 was 3 8 up one point from the 3 7 of the previous week. Broilers averaged 17 66 and mash cost the grower \$92 42 per ton.

Georgia reported prices of 16 to 16 5 at farms with most of the sales at the 16 cent figure.

Offerings cleared closely though adequate for the decreased, no better than fair
