One will be left undisturbed as a check plot Another will be clipped for weeds Liquid chemical went on another before seeding and the same chemical in granular form on still another Two of the plots will be treated 30 days after seeding with two new weedleides


Berggren plans to be at the plots during the field days, and expects that response to the different weed control measures will be enough varied that farmers will be able to mak- their own comparisons
