Two important ingredients needed by crops are calcum and magnesium. Both of these are regularly lost through the soil by the following ways

I By leaching (a slow leaking away - a normal process where there is rainfall.)

2. By crop removals (leumes, suchyas hay and other greens, are taken off the fields, instead of plowed under.)

3. By general use of the Soil

Because of this loss, the soil becomes what is known as high in acid. Putting on limestone may supply calcium and magnesium and rorrect the soil acidity at the same time.

It has been shown by experiments by agricultural colleges and experiment starions that for every dollar spent for limestone, from \$3 to \$15 are returned to the talmer through increased crop yields
